Join us for the third event of Contemporary African Voices, a webinar series shining a light on acclaimed sub-Saharan writers. The series aims to amplify African voices and to educate by introducing stories deeply rooted in Africa written by Africans. We come to know a country by reading its writers.

In *No Be From Hia*, the Ayomides and Kombes - Zambian-Nigerian-Jamaican powerhouse families brought together during the post-colonial migration of the 1960's to the UK - are separated by death, divorce, and betrayal. Scattered between London, Lusaka, and Lagos, only the new generation can save this family.
